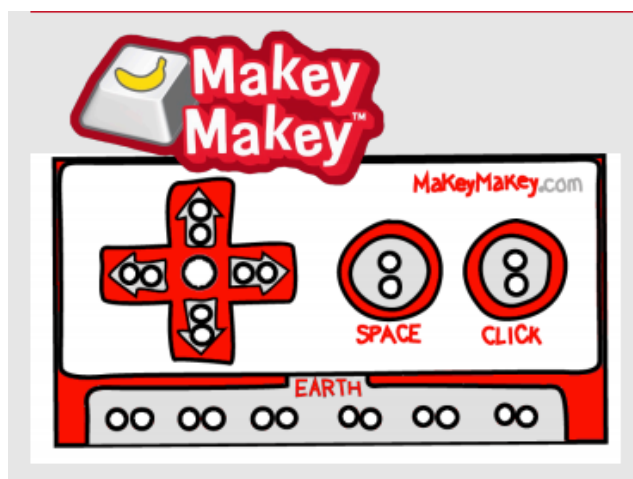

Technology Requirements: School computers (PC) will be available for use. You may bring your own laptop and charging cable. Windows, Mac, Chromebook, Linux operating systems work great. Tablets will not work. Regardless of the laptop used, it must have the ability to plugin a USB "type A" plug - these are the most common type of USB plugs and it is how the Makey Makey is connected to a computer. Some new laptops do not accept a USB type A plug so the user must supply their own adaptor ("dongle").

NOTE: Sometimes school issued laptops are "locked down" or have some restriction placed on them. Make sure you're able to access the internet outside of school and all websites (like Youtube).
